God Chose Abram, Verse 7. Abram was not even looking for God. He worshipped the God of his father, a non-god.

Abram was probably like his father a polytheist, a worshipper of many gods. God Called Abram, and made a one-sided Covenant with Abram, God's Chosen. He then changed both Abram and Sarai's name once they trusted God alone.

Abraham was a polytheist prior to Genesis 12, and he likely was aware of Yahweh (God). It is not clear if Abraham in his own way also worshipped God along with other false gods his father worshipped prior to his conversion. What is clear is that God's Call of Abraham in Genesis 12 was a conversion as Abraham was converted from polytheism to the monotheistic worship of God alone. Abraham came to reject other gods and worship the I Am, Yahweh, God the Father alone rejected all the false 'gods' he learned from his father.

Question: Can someone who is Elected by God The Father, Do they not hear God's Word through humans, Holy Scripture, nature, etc? If they are Elected, I would believe God would pursue him/her to be sure all His Elect hear His Word. Once Chosen, doesn't God pursue? i.e: Hosea?

Yes. They will hear and believe. However, many are Called to hear God' Holy Word, the Gospel Message in Sacred Scriptures, the Holy Bible concerning the Lord Jesus Christ. They have heard a Preacher, or have been witnessed to. However, we must understand that billions have never heard of the Lord Jesus Christ and have died. Billions are alive today that will never hear the Word of God before they die. Whole nations forbid the Holy Bible, Preaching, Teaching, Witnessing of the Lord Jesus Christ. They were not Chosen of God for Salvation.

Question: Can someone Elected, pursued, decide NOT to follow God? So they hear, but choose to not follow Christ. Why would an all knowing God pick someone who will NOT accept Him? Once Chosen, is it only a matter of time before they accept Christ?

If Chosen of God, one of God's Elect, His Called, they will believe. They may be drawn, but fall away, but at a later time believe if they are of the Elect. No man does ANYTHING for his own Salvation. It is Grace alone. Since man does nothing for his Salvation, since he is Chosen by God, he does nothing to "un-believe" that is he cannot lose his Salvation. Why? Those that are the Elect of God are a love gift from God the Father to God the Son:

4 And the **mixt multitude that was among them fell a lusting: and the children of Israel also wept again, and said, Who shall give us flesh to eat?**

Note: Remember they came out of Egypt in a **mixt**

multitude (they had married Egyptians,) and those that were now in Israel were not all of Israel.

Note: Two things, the **mixt multitude** (those that had inter-married with Egyptians and accepted their false 'gods' those not to be Saved) HATED the manna, and wanted Egyptian food. To others, the True Worshipers of God, said that it tasted like wafers of honey (reflective of the judgments of the Lord which are true and righteous altogether . . . sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.

Psalm 19:9-11, <https://www.biblegateway.com/passage/?search=Psalm%2019%3A9%2D11&version=KJV>) and of fresh oil (Oil is representative of the Holy Spirit). Notice, before the Manna (which represents the Son of God, the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth comes, the dew first falls upon the camp in the night. In the night, before the Light of the World, the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth appears, this Manna that came down from Heaven appears in the night (of the world) darkened by sin . . . when the dew, the water, which represents the Word of God brought forth by the Holy Spirit which appears and prepares the camp, (the Believers) then the Manna falls upon them who Believe, those Born Again, and it is a sweet taste in their mouths: the taste of the Holy Spirit, of God's Word, God's Truth -- the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth, God's Way to

Heaven, is not hated by God's Elect like those who hated (and today still hate) the Manna sent down from Heaven, the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth.

Question: When they were children, they accepted Christ. Then fell away as they got older. Is there Hope?

Yes.

Question: They excepted Christ as children but no longer give Christ importance. Their lifestyles show they may be Believers. But, we are NOT saved by works. Only their Fruits show they may be Christians. Only God knows what is happening in their hearts and minds. They are NOT evangelists, they keep their faith private. Are they Saved?

We are NOT Called to keep our faith private. We are to proclaim the Good News of the Gospel to every Creature. One of the signs of being Saved is desiring to hear the Truth of the Gospel message, and wanting to share the Gospel with others. It does not have to be in big ways, but definitely not to keep one's faith to themselves, and not to desire to "keep their faith private".

Question: I know we can only be saved by Grace. But, are my family members Elected?

Maybe, maybe not. They are not Saved because you are Saved.

Acts 2:39

39 For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.

People don't understand Acts 2:39. They have whole 'churches' that believe this means if you are Saved then your children are Saved. This, though, means that the same Promise that is to you, is the same Promise given by God to your children and those that are far off in other lands, or far from the Lord where ever they are (even within your family) ALL receive Salvation by the same promise, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, Acts 16:20-31, and thou (thou in KJV is singular, you can substitute the word you, you individually) shall be Saved. This is the promise to you and your children, the same promise made to each generation. Believe and be Saved -- even as many as the Lord our God shall call!, Acts 2:39.

I love Holy Scripture, the Holy Bible. It doesn't say, as many as might decide, but as many as the Lord our God SHALL Call.

31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house.

Question: Are my family members Saved?

When they are, there will be a change toward the Lord Jesus Christ, and they will desire to tell others, and not be ashamed.

We do not know who the Elect are; we are simply under Command of our Lord Jesus Christ to Preach the Word to ALL creatures (Creatures are created beings, human beings or Angels (including fallen Angels):

Question: If they are Elected, will they stay alive until they are Saved, confess their faith in God? The thief on the cross with Christ was Saved that day.

If they are the Elect of God, they will stay alive until they are Saved. They must believe and confess the Lord Jesus Christ as their Savior, believing this in their heart. (The heart to the Jew is what we call the subconscious, the deepest part of a

man. The part where we "know" things, not just mentally assent to it, but believe them with certainty, with conviction that they are true or false.)

At the end of the world, only the Elect are Saved. All others follow the antiChrist -- the 'pope' of Rome.
