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Liberal establishment domination of U.S. Republican vs. Democrat system



The table below, in combination with ISGP's <u>Superclass Index</u>, should make it quite obvious that the Rockefeller group and their primary protege, Henry Kissinger, together with a little help from George Shultz and Bechtel, have dominated U.S. politics since at least the Eisenhower

administration. Of course, ISGP has a separate article on the <u>Pilgrims Society</u>, complete with unique photocopies of membership lists. All names can be verified with impeccable sources.




John D. "Jay" Rockefeller, IV and Dianne Feinstein of the Senate Intelligence Committee - tasked with overseeing the intelligence agencies - an establishment power base in the senate. Sen. Bob Graham, also tied to elite think tanks, has also served on the committee for a long time and as chairman before Rockefeller. Rockefeller has been a pre-2002 member, vice-chair 2002-2007, chair 2007-2009, and regular member since. Congress' counterpart has been led by elites as later CIA director Porter Goss and Jane Harman. [53] ISGP has an Superclass Index so people can check all these ties for themselves.

What does the above list tell us? It tells us that whole Republican vs. Democrat system has been rigged. The liberal Rockefeller establishment is both Republican and Democrat. The masses are encouraged to debate about creationism vs evolution, medicare and tax rates, but when it comes to long-term foreign policy, from economic integration to the War on Terror, the same agenda keeps going, no matter who is in office. That should have become blatantly obvious after Barack Obama came into office. Despite a toning down of the Christian rhetoric and more cooperation with the United Nations and NATO, the War on Terror, foreign interventions and the eroding of civil liberties continued virtually unhindered.

There's no doubt that many other more recent names can be listed as Pilgrims Society members once modern membership lists become available. The last complete one ISGP has been able to acquire dates to 1980.

Below is another way of looking at the top positions of government, the route towards it, and at what level of government the top think tanks and foundations become important. One can see that the secretary of state, the secretary of defense, the national security advisor and their immediate deputies are basically always involved in the major think tanks and NGOs, both *before* and after their terms in office. Presidents and their running mates almost always come from the outside and will only get national media exposure after they have been vetted. Ron Paul's popularity in recent years almost exclusively came through the internet, but in his case it can also be argued that he receives massive support from fringe John Birch-type extremists.



The end of the Rockefeller era of globalization?



Decades-long close friends Henry Kissinger and David Rockefeller.

One thing that should be taken into account is that the average age of the Rockefeller clique at the top of ISGP's <u>Superclass Index</u> is about 85. David Rockefeller is 98, George Shultz is 92, Henry Kissinger is 90, etc. There's no clear heir to David Rockefeller, who, along with his family, built almost the complete worldwide network of NGOs. It will be interesting to see how

the liberal establishment, which for almost a century has had the Rockefeller family to rally around, will adapt to this new situation, especially in a world with dwindling national resources. Compare this to the neoconservatives under men like James Woolsey and Dick Cheney, who have an average age of "just" 68. Include some of the more senior CIA officers, who appear to play a role in controlling the neocon movement, and the average age goes up to about 72 - still two decades younger than the most important members of the Rockefeller clique. It does appear that the neocons do not have access to the same amount of funds the liberal establishment has, which has dozens of major foundations and multinationals funding its network of NGOs. However, the trend in the U.S. establishment definitely points to more cooperation with Israel, a primary trademark of the neocons. Back in 2005 the New York Times reported that U.S. aid had reached "\$100 billion since Israel was founded in 1948"; it's unlikely that this will be scaled back anytime soon. At one point the liberal establishment didn't care much for Israel, favoring Arab oil. This is almost unheard of these days. Kissinger, Shultz, Peterson, Greenberg and a few other friends have numerous ties to Jewish businessmen and the Israeli government. It seems that the lobby, which most definitely has been aided by number of CIA elites, isn't going anywhere.

In any case, with the most dominant members of the Rockefeller group soon gone, it will be interesting to see how U.S. elites evolve and the impact it will have on U.S. relations with the rest of the world. Maybe little. Maybe a lot. It may sound strange, but until we know who <u>rigged those World Trade Center towers</u>, we have no clue about the behind-the-scenes balance of power between CIA elites, State Department elites and the international Zionist movement. Or even the Knights of Malta and Opus Dei, who also play a role in these establishment networks.

State Department, CIA, or something else?

This is a question that comes up rather often when discussing conspiracies: where does the State Department begin and the CIA end? These days a lot of "democracy-sponsoring" goes through a network of think tanks and foundations that includes Freedom House, the National Endowment for Democracy, the International Republican Institute, George Soros' Open Society Institute, the National Democratic Institute, the Council for a Community of Democracies and related groups. The boards of these groups are stacked with persons from ISGP's <u>Superclass Index</u> - and they all cooperate and coordinate. A great example of this coordination has been given by the Economics Education and Research Consortium (EERC) in the Ukraine, back when it first established a website. Key founder and honorary chairman of the EERC is the Zionist oligarch Victor Pinchuk. In order to get his funding, Pinchuk went to his friends at the Peterson Institute for International Economics, with directors as David Rockefeller, Lynn Forester de Rothschild, George Shultz, Paul Volcker, Maurice Greenberg, Peter Peterson and Conrad Black. Pinchuk himself joined the board in later years. According to the EERC itself, back when the website was first up many years ago:

"In 1993 several [World] Bank staff began to discuss launching a capacity building program in the Former Soviet Union. ... Others outside the Bank were also enthusiastic about such an initiative, including representatives of the Soros Foundation and the Eurasia Foundation...

"These discussions led to a meeting in May 1994 in New York with representatives from potential donor organizations and a few academics with an interest in the region.

Potential donors included the Carnegie Corporation, Eurasia Foundation, Ford Foundation, Kress Foundation, Mott Foundation, Rockefeller Foundation, Soros Foundation, and World Bank. The academics included Zvi Griliches from Harvard and Stanley Fischer from MIT. As a result of that meeting, The World Bank and Eurasia Foundation agreed to carry out an assessment of the needs and capabilities of economic education and research institutions in Russia and Ukraine. [and soon the EERC was set up]."

Only a few years before, proteges of Peterson Institute directors Peter Peterson and Larry Summers had begun to advise Yeltsin's government on neoliberal reforms. Officially these men were Harvard economists, although Putin later referred to them as "CIA personnel" and "intelligence officers". To make things even more complex, almost everyone involved in the economic reform and subsequent siphoning off of billions in IMF funds were either Jewish or Zionist - usually both.

So where does one establishment end and another begin? Where does Russian Zionism end and the Mossad begin? Where does the CIA end and the State Department begin? Or where does private enterprise begin? It's all nearly impossible to tell. Maurice Greenberg of the Peterson Institute and AIG was very close to CIA director William Casey and at different times has been recommended for the position of deputy director and director of the CIA. CIA directors Walter Bedell-Smith, Allen Dulles, John McCone, Richard Helms, Robert Gates and John Deutch all were/are close friends of this Rockefeller clique. Directors as James Schlesinger and William Casey did have their problems with members of the Rockefeller group - they were more hawkish during the Cold War - but there's also been a lot of cooperation at other times.

Retired CIA directors have always mingled with retired secretaries of state and defense secretaries, always ready to advise the next generation of political candidates. Back in 1993, after George H. W. Bush was defeated by Clinton, this was perfectly illustrated with the founding of the Forum for International Policy (FFIP) and the Virginia Neurological Institute. Both were closely-knit groups with founding directors that included Kissinger protege Brent Scowcroft, Bush's former national security advisor; Kissinger protege Lawrence Eagleburger, Bush's former secretary of state; and Bush's former CIA director, Robert Gates. Other FFIP directors were future Condoleezza Rice, Bush's expert on Russia; and Colin Powell, chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff under Bush. In 1997, after resigning as CIA director, John Deutch completed the FFIP board.

Rice, Powell and Gates would resurface in the administration of George W. Bush as secretaries of state, national security advisor and defense secretary. Until that time they were involved in numerous NGOs and corporations with other members of the establishment. Powell served on the board of the Knights of Malta- and Bush family-dominated AmeriCares board. He was a director of the Forstmann Little-owned Gulfstream Corporation, together with Henry Kissinger, Donald Rumsfeld, Lynn Forester de Rothschild and George Shultz. In the same period George Shultz brought Rice onto the boards of Chevron, Transamerica, the Charles Schwab Corporation and JPMorgan Chase. These are just a few examples of how Powell and Rice, not to mention Gates, were quite literally groomed by the establishment for future government positions.

Speaking of grooming, there's at least one interesting report that's not been discussed yet on this site. In November 2006 a series of emails was published on the internet, written by a person who

claimed to be have been the driver of Paul Dietrich. ISGP stumbled across these emails when doing background checks on Paul Dietrich and his wife, Laura, whose names appeared in a list of visitors of a meeting of Le Cercle, a small and very secretive CIA-Vatican liaison group. ISGP was the first to publish photocopies of membership lists of the group. Who's Who information demonstrated that both Paul and his wife belonged to the Knights of Malta. At the same time it was claimed in these emails that Laura was groomed by a CIA "fast track" program for a high government position, along with Condoleezza Rice.

"It was while we were sitting in the parlor at Huntland during our initial meeting talking about his wife that he let slip that she was involved in something that he called "spy school". He informed me that she is a crack shot with an AK-47 and that she often brags about "killing" spies before coming home and preparing dinner. ...

"He started telling me about his wife's involvement with the CIA. Paul told me that Laura had been involved in a "fast track" program with the CIA at Georgetown to recruit women in high position roles in the federal government. This was at the beginning of the Reagan era and was facilitated by Jeane Kirkpatrick. Condoleezza Rice had also been a part of this program. He told me that the position Laura had held at State, Deputy Assistant Secretary for Human Rights and Humanitarian Affairs was a front for the CIA at the State Department. ...

"Paul told me that she was one of "Bolton's girls," the gaggle of very attractive female assistants that John **Bolton** had trailing behind him when he entered Senate hearing chambers on Capitol Hill, etc. ...

"Paul told me that his wife was on an intelligence board and had been hand-picked by Donald **Rumsfeld**. James **Woolsey** is also on this Defense Department (?) intelligence board. Paul didn't elaborate any further on this. However I suspected the board was involved with DIA or at least met at Bolling Air Force Base as Laura had DoD stickers on her car that allowed her to enter that base.

"Paul told me that the counter-terrorism work Laura did involved a team that would go and gather every detail of a terrorist incident world-wide. ...

"[Laura] worked for the CIA and was currently employed training recruits. ... I personally saw Laura Dietrich's tax information and pay stubs, the private military contractors she worked for are: MPRI, Armorgroup, Tessada & Associates, Hamilton Trading Group, Inc." [22]

Checking up on some of the information, Laura Dietrich certainly did work for Bolton [23] and was active at the State Department in returning refugees ("commies") to countries as El Salvador, to be butchered by various CIA/ASC/Cercle-related death squad leaders as Roberto D'Aubuisson, Mario Sandoval, Colonel Enrique Bermudez, Stedman Fagoth and others. [24] She was also unusually slim and attractive for a politician. Also interesting is the statement from the alleged former driver that Paul handled an account for Mikhail Gorbachev. Coincidentally, in 1992 Paul was a founding trustee of the Gorbachev Foundation/USA, with George Shultz as chair of the advisory board. In this same period Paul and his wife ran the questionable Institute

for International Health and Development (IIHD), which tried to counter the WHO's antismoking stance. The younger sister of later PNAC founder William Kristol was executive director of the IIHD.

Looking deeper into some of the other names mentioned, until her death Jeane Kirkpatrick was among the most connected elitists in the west. All the institutes she was involved with can be found in ISGP's <u>Superclass Index</u>. As ISGP's American Security Council article describes, Kirkpatrick played an important behind-the-scenes role in providing U.S. support for terrorism in South Africa aimed to uphold apartheid - in direct opposition to official State Department policy. Certainly if anyone would be in a position to set up clandestine CIA programs it would be Jeane Kirkpatrick. Like the Dietrichs, she is also known to have visited Le Cercle. Rumsfeld and Woolsey, both high up in ISGP's <u>Superclass Index</u>, would have known each other for years through the CIA-linked H. Smith Richardson Foundation, the Defense Policy Board and other non-government groups. Woolsey also just happens to be the number one person involved in Pentagon federal advisory committees. The DOD committee described here, however, doesn't appear to be an official committee, as Laura's name can't be found anywhere in Federal Advisory Committee Act (FACA) lists. In fact, it can't even be shown that Laura is still alive today.

Whether the above information is true or not, it's hard to talk about State Department policy or CIA policy. Ultimately these are just bureaucratic organizations with PR departments. It's the people running them, including their network of friends, that matter - not the other 99 percent of the employees in the organization. It appears that "real politik" is decided on in the back rooms and at dinner parties, much like any other group of friends would make decisions. Persons that are met with can range from heads of major foundations and think tanks, to covert operations specialists, corporate leaders, and representatives of foreign governments. In the same way it's a virtual certainty that the owners of the media are approached through these same unofficial channels for a variety of leaks and cover ups. As ISGP's Pilgrims Society article shows, the heads of the major media outlets are very much part of the establishment.

The neoconservative non-establishment



Paul Wolfowitz and Douglas Feith, the two highest-ranked Zionist neocons in the history of the U.S. government. Wolfowitz was Rumsfeld's deputy secretary of defense from 2001 to 2005, with Feith serving as under secretary of defense for policy. Both came out of Sen. Jackson's Zionist "fifth column" office. Wolfowitz in particular has numerous liberal establishment ties: George Shultz, State Department, Bilderberg, Aspen, World Bank, and more.

Earlier we demonstrated Rockefeller domination of the U.S. political system. At the same time it must be acknowledged that the Republican Party is split among liberal Rockefeller Republicans and a radical conservative wing, which in turn is split into the influential pro-Israel "neoconservatives" and the increasingly marginal traditional right wing: the antisemitic "old right" and "new right" of the Cold War. One major problem with these right-wing establishments

is that they have been dominated by the CIA and the Pentagon ever since the creation of the national security state. ISGP's article on the <u>American Security Council</u> and its neoconservative follow-up, the Center for Security Policy, made this painfully clear, as well as ISGP's article on <u>Le Cercle</u>.

There's been much talk about the "neoconservatives" ever since George Bush was elected president in 2000. There isn't really a definitive answer as to what a "neoconservative" is, although the obvious, yet politically incorrect, answer is that they have an "Israel uber alles" mentality. Donald Rumsfeld and Dick Cheney have been labeled "neoconservatives". The problem is, as ISGP's index of institutes demonstrates, that these men have been very comfortable with the liberal establishment, having held important positions in groups ranging from the CFR and the Bretton Woods Committee to the Eisenhower Fellowships and the Atlantic Institute of International Affairs. They do support Israel much stronger than almost anyone in the liberal establishment, but does this make these men part of an entirely new establishment? Hardly. Throughout the 1990s Rumsfeld even was a director of Gulfstream, together with George Shultz, Colin Powell, Henry Kissinger and Lynn Forester de Rothschild. Upon seeing Cheney's puppy dog face when taking a question from David Rockefeller at the Council on Foreign Relations and hearing his introduction--quoted below--and it's immediately clear that Cheney is extremely close to the liberal establishment:

"It's good to be back at the Council on Foreign Relations. As Pete [Peterson] mentioned, I've been a member for a long time and was actually a director for some period of time. I never mentioned that when I was campaigning for re-election back home in Wyoming." [25]

If Rumsfeld and Cheney aren't true neoconservatives, independent of the liberal establishment, then who are? Well, maybe there are none. Virtually all well known neoconservatives fall into one or more of the categories below:

- 1. Mid-level Pentagon employees.
- 2. National security scholars.
- 3. Executives of CIA and Pentagon-linked think tanks.

Well known neoconservatives include Richard Perle, Edward Luttwak, Paul Wolfowitz, Elliott Abrams, Douglas Feith, Frank Gaffney, Dov Zakheim, Irving Kristol, William Kristol, Joshua Muravchik, Richard Pipes and Daniel Pipes. The fact is, while being influential in a whole range of NGOs, these "neocons" never rose to top positions in the U.S. government (structure of promotion listed a few pages earlier). Wolfowitz held the highest office: as Rumsfeld's deputy secretary of defense from 2001 to 2005. Douglas Feith, as under secretary of defense for policy, served under Wolfowitz, and, together with AIPAC henchmen as Steven Rosen and Keith Weissman, collected much of the dirty propaganda to make a U.S. invasion of Iraq possible. Back in the early 1980s, Feith served under Richard Perle in the Defense Department.



WINEP research director Patrick Clawson in 2012 when he says: "Look people, Iranian submarines periodically go down; some day one of them may not come up. Who would know why? We can do a variety of things if we wish to increase the pressure." Clawson openly suggested a false flag-type attack to bring the U.S. into war with Iran. The advisory board of WINEP, a Zionist think tank, has included top neocons as James Woolsey, Richard Perle, Paul Wolfowitz, in addition to Liberal Establishment representatives as Henry Kissinger and George Shultz. Dov Zakheim has also been a major player in WINEP. There's no doubt that Israel is maintaining a fifth column in the U.S. through WINEP, AIPAC, CPMAJO and other groups.

Bush appointed Perle chairman of the Defense Policy Board in 2001, but this is not an official government position and already in 2003 he was forced to step down. Back when Reagan came into office in 1981, Perle did have an official position at the Defense Department, but counted Fred Ikle and General Richard Stilwell, a former CIA chief in the Far East, among his superiors here. Throughout the 1980s these men were key liaisons to the secretive Cercle group, most likely arranged through the connections of their boss, deputy secretary of defense Frank Carlucci. Carlucci was a friend of controversial CIA spook Ted Shackley, who seemingly controlled the Cercle group. Carlucci is actually said to have made a decision with Shackley, General Vernon Walters (ASC), George H. W. Bush and others, to try and foment a silent CIA coup of the White House in the late 1970s, which took the form of the hawkish Reagan administration. [26] As we know that Carlucci, Shackley and Bush were close associates and friends from the 1970s on and into the 21st century, [27] it's not surprising either that Rumsfeld, a childhood friend and political protege of Carlucci; and George W. Bush, the son of George H. W. Bush, allowed the neocons to return. However, the neocons do not control anything. They are always brought in as assistants.

As has been discussed in some detail in ISGP's <u>American Security Council</u> article, many neocons originated from the office of Senator Henry Jackson to be employed as "detente wreckers", the famous policy embraced by Henry Kissinger, the Rockefellers and the State Department as a whole. Back in the 1970s Richard Perle, Edward Luttwak (earlier Perle's roommate at the London School of Economics), Paul Wolfowitz, Elliott Abrams, Douglas Feith and Frank Gaffney were all employed here.

Richard Pipes, who used to be on the board of the CIA- and Pentagon-dominated American Security Council, served as an advisor to Jackson in the 1970s. Gaffney founded the Center for Security Policy, the unofficial neocon successor of the American Security Council. Luttwak worked at the prestigious CSIS think tank for several decades. In this capacity he has been a permanent consultant to various special operations branches of the Pentagon, the national security council, the State Department, and, unofficially, the CIA covert operations clique surrounding Ted Shackley. Still, Gaffney, Pipes, Luttwak, and fellow-neocon Joshua Muravchik, never held any official government positions. They somehow made a name for themselves as outside consultants.

True, apart from Perle, a few other neocons also held official positions in the U.S. government. William Kristol, the famous founder of the Project for the New American Century, was chief of staff to vice president Dan Quayle in the administration of George H. W. Bush. Dov Zakheim was another mid-level Pentagon employee under Reagan who was reappointed during the administration of George W. Bush, in his case as under secretary of defense (comptroller). That's about it. All this stands in stark contrast to the more than 30 NGOs and Pentagon advisory groups Zakheim has been involved in until this point, quite often alongside former CIA director James Woolsey. Kristol held about 20 such positions. His father, Irving Kristol, infamously cofounded Encounter magazine for the CIA.



Senator Henry Jackson, an absolute favorite of the CIA, American Security Council, Le Cercle, and Israel. On whose behalf exactly did he run a Zionist fifth column from his senate office? Here we have one senator employing Perle, Wolfowitz, Feith, Luttwak, Gaffney, Pipes and Abrams as staffers, years before most of them rose to prominence. This might well be one of the most important overlooked facts in American history, still waiting for a decent explanation.

If anything, the vast majority of neocons, if not all of them, appear to be toys of the CIA and mainly used as liaisons to the Israeli government. As has been discussed by ISGP, the CIA, mainly through the private club of men as Richard Helms, Ted Shackley, Frank Carlucci and George H. W. Bush, has maintained relations with the Vatican-Paneuropa network (Le Cercle), the Saudis (Safari Club), and, seemingly through the neocons, Israel. Just the latest example I ran across is Edward Luttwak, an expert on death squads and coups, who can be tied to Giancarlo Elia Valori through Italintesa and an Aspen Institute-sponsored meeting in Italy. [28] Valori used to be a Cercle member [29] and one of the key players in the P2 Lodge, part of the terrorist Strategy of Tension in Italy. To this day he has top-level friends in the United States and the Israel lobby, and is still suspected to be a major behind-the-scenes power player.

Almost certainly Valori was well-acquainted with Michael Ledeen, another fascist Zionist extremist, at the time of Italy's false flag bombings, the Banco Ambrosiano scandal and the subsequent P2 affair. Ledeen was operating in Italy as a SISMI military intelligence "risk consultant". He primarily worked with controversial SISMI asset Francesco Pazienza, with P2 member General Giuseppe Santovito being the head of SISMI at the time. Both Pazienza and Santovito were close associates of Valori, who in more recent decades turned from a Vatican insider to being one of the closest friends of radical Zionism. [30]

Of course, Ledeen also never held any official government position. He's just an academic and journalist who shows up wherever some kind of conspiracy is suspected, whether it's an

assassination attempt on the pope, Iran Contra, or the Iraq invasion. Unsurprisingly, Ledeen has been close to CIA covert operation veterans as William Colby and especially Ted Shackley for many decades.

Senator Jackson himself was closely linked to this same CIA group. In 1973 he worked closely with top CIA officers Ted Shackley, William Colby and James Schlesinger in undermining the Church Committee's inquiries into Richard Helms' illegal CIA projects: MK-ULTRA, the Kennedy assassination, coups, Mockingbird, etc. [31] Jackson is also known to have been a darling of the American Security Council and to have visited the secretive Cercle group of Shackley, although it was mainly Perle or an assistant of his, Pat Balestreri, who showed up as a Pentagon liaison to Le Cercle in the 1980s. Wolfowitz visited Le Cercle in the early 1990s.

How exactly did this network come about? We don't really know the details, but Perle, as well as Wolfowitz, was sent to Jackson's office by Albert Wohlstetter, one of the godfathers of neoconservatism who was a veteran of the RAND Corporation and various national security think tanks, all linked to the Pentagon and the CIA.



Top neocon Richard Perle. Backed by Ted Shackley (CIA), Frank Carlucci (CIA), James Schlesinger (CIA), James Woolsey (CIA); Conrad Black (Hollinger and Bilderberg), Netanyahu (Israel), to a degree by George Shultz (Bechtel) and even works with Henry Kissinger on many occasions these days (Bilderberg, National Interest and various company boards). But where is the "neocon establishment?" It doesn't exist. All neocons are low to mid-level DOD employees, CIA-Mossad liaison officers and political science professors involved in various think tanks. So why is everyone talking about the neocon takeover of the US government?

Interestingly, Richard Perle is actually not the most connected neocon of all. Ranked far above him on the neoconservative ladder is the ultraconnected CIA spook James Woolsey, the number 2 in ISGP's <u>Superclass Index</u>, right behind Henry Kissinger. Indeed, Woolsey has been involved in more think tanks and advisory bodies than a George Shultz or David Rockefeller. Since 9/11, Woolsey has played a role in almost every think tank and action group set up by the neocons, often alongside Richard Perle and Dov Zakheim. Woolsey, however, has always been intricately connected to the core of the liberal establishment, best illustrated by his support for anti-global warming measures, Yale and Rhodes Scholarship background (Senators of his 1993 CIA senate confirmation hearing were joking about Rhodes scholars taking over the administration and being so deeply involved in intelligence), membership in the CFR since 1975, directorship of the Atlantic Council since 1981, positions at the Smithsonian, and vice chairmanship of the CSIS think tank by 1988 [32], where already at that point he shared the board with Henry Kissinger, Maurice Greenberg, Zbigniew Brzezinski, Claiborne Pell (closest of friends with the Liechtenstein family) the previously-mentioned Etienne Davignon and Baron Edmond de Rothschild. [33] The neocon Edward Luttwak, of course, was equally active at CSIS.

At the same time Woolsey was the ultimate arms industry insider--probably for the CIA--as a lawyer and director of corporations as British Aerospace, DynCorp, Martin Marietta, McDonnell Douglas, Litton Industries, Fairchild Industries, Rockwell, SAIC, the Titan Corporation, United Technologies, General Dynamics and also the Carlyle Group. [34] In 1987 and 1988 Woolsey was a member of the Scientific Advisory Group of the Joint Strategic Targetting and Planning Staff at Offutt Air Force Base. Worryingly, this is where part of the Franklin Affair mind control research took place, with Woolsey and his wife, a national security behavioral psychologist, being rather closely linked to the affair. [35]

Woolsey's first association with the neoconservatives, as far as ISGP can figure things out, appears to have been at the Executive Panel of the Chief of Naval Operations when he joined it in 1980. Archneocon Albert Wohlstetter, a RAND scientist and Pentagon consultant who had sent Perle and Wolfowitz to Senator Jackson's office, served on the Executive Panel from 1971 until his death in 1997. Woolsey actually beat him in terms of longest-serving member, still being a member today.

In 1988 Woolsey's neocon ties were solidified when he joined the board of the Jewish Institute for National Security Affairs (JINSA) [36], co-founded a decade earlier by Senator Henry Jackson (there he is again) and Iran-Contra veteran Michael Ledeen [37], who, just as Jackson, was close to CIA officers Ted Shackley, of Le Cercle, and Ray Cline, a co-chair of the American Security Council and the U.S. Global Strategy Council. There's every indication that back in the 1970s and early 1980s Ledeen was a key U.S. liaison to the fascist P2 Lodge for Shackley at the CIA and Alexander Haig (Pilgrims and Kissinger protege) at the State Department. [38] Richard Perle, Paul Wolfowitz (co-chair), Douglas Feith (vice-chair), and even Morris Amitay, AIPAC's executive director, could all be found at JINSA no later than the early 1990s. [39] Ledeen, Perle, and Woolsey stayed on the board of JINSA until early 2012 when a dispute arose with a more moderate lead financier of JINSA and all three prominently resigned. [40] Clearly the three men had grown very close over the decades.

Woolsey, Ledeen and also Perle, through his association with Le Cercle, clearly are all CIA. There's every indication that Woolsey was already CIA when he established Yale Citizens for Eugene McCarthy for President in 1967, a curious anti-Vietnam War candidate apparently in the business of educating hippies to cut their hair and dress properly. In other words, Woolsey's 1993 appointment as CIA director doesn't appear to have been a coincidence and as a lifelong CIA officer, it's also questionable that Woolsey's appointment to the board of JINSA and dozens of later neocon outfits has been a coincidence.



Former CIA director and top-neocon James Woolsey, ranked number 2 in ISGP's <u>Superclass Index</u>, right behind Henry Kissinger. Here Woolsey is arguing that Edward Snowden should be hanged for having exposed questionable and even unlawful spy operations of the NSA.

Personally I suspect Woolsey has been picked by the private CIA network set up by Richard Helms and Ted Shackley, and today still counts George H. W. Bush and Frank Carlucci among its ranking members, as the network's chief liaison to the Israel lobby. If anybody is managing the neoconservative movement from behind the scenes, at least from the U.S. side, it would be Woolsey. Woolsey has definitely been close to this CIA group, as his co-chairmanship of the Association of Former Intelligence Officers and the OSS Society, both with George H. W. Bush, demonstrates. Other former CIA officers as James Schlesinger, Frank Carlucci, Richard Helms have also been involved with these groups. Ted Shackley was a key player in the AFIO until his death in 2002. Clearly all these men knew each other very well, but Woolsey's old CIA ties remain obscure. His Pentagon, neocon and liberal establishment ties are very clear, however.

Woolsey and Cheney may both have been assigned to manage the neoconservative movement, as Cheney was a board member of JINSA from 1993 to 1999. Cheney and Woolsey, who reportedly are close, also know each other from the board of the Jamestown Foundation and the Center for Security Policy. Both men appear to be deep insiders to the United States' most illegal black programs, as the men's association with the Russian firm Far West alone seems to indicate. [41] When it comes to any major black program the Pentagon might be running, it's hard to imagine Woolsey not being aware of it to some degree - as a lot of <u>Unacknowledged SpecialAccess Programs</u> (USAPs) seem to be hidden in private industry. On top of that, Woolsey has served on numerous low profile Pentagon committees. Who the heck has ever heard of the Outer Continental Shelf Policy Committee (OCSPC), the Deterrence Concepts Advisory Group (DCAG), the Disruptive Technology Committee, the Future of Navy Force Structure (FNFS), or the Navy Personnel Policy (NPP)? Not a lot of people, but Woolsey served on all of them.

The high-tech defense industry and revolutionary new energy devices



The elusive and elite Global Technology Partners, LLC, a spin-off of William Perry's and Paul Kaminski's Technology Strategies & Alliances, whose long-time head was Adm. David Jeremiah, a deep Pentagon black program insider who also could be found at Wackenhut and JINSA. Virtually the same partners since its founding in 1997, in 2000 GTP allied itself with Rothschild North America. [54] GTP's website has been mostly off-line over the years. Perry and Kaminski played key roles in the development of stealth technology. Deutch was head of the CIA, and, along with Ashton Carter, also appears in ISGP's Superclass Index. John Stenbit is among the U.S.' most important national security scientists/executives, listed at a shared 4th place in ISGP's 'Defense Science & Technology' Superclass Index, behind John S. Foster, Jr., Philip Odeen, and Adm. David Jeremiah.

ISGP's <u>Superclass Index</u> has a section labeled '<u>Defense Science & Technology</u>'. The names in this list are the elite of the elite when it comes to high tech defense programs in the United States. These persons, along with retired CIA and defense department elites also named in ISGP's <u>Superclass Index</u>, have been involved in corporations as TRW, Lockheed, Northrop, SAIC, Raytheon, United Technologies, ManTech, In-Q-Tel, Defense Group, Inc. and Global Technology Partners.

This same group, many of whom hardly show up in any of the globalist or neoconservative NGOs, dominates the Defense Science Board (DSB). The DSB really seems to be the only place where most of the elite of the national security scientists, along with corporate and political elites overseeing various black programs, come together. The head of the DSB is picked by the president. Chairman of the Defense Science Board throughout the George W. Bush administration was William Schneider, Jr., a neocon who could also be found at the Center for Security Policy, Le Cercle and PNAC. These same national security scientists can be found on such bodies as the National Security Advisory Board (NSAAB), the Executive Panel of the Chief of Naval Operations, the NRO Technical Advisory Group, the CIA's National Security Advisory Panel. The Directorate of Science & Technology of the CIA is more important, but this is an official government body - not an "outside" oversight or consultancy group. Until the late 1950s, the Air Force Scientific Advisory Board (AFSAB) also featured some of the most elite national security scientists on its board, but this isn't the case anymore today.

Last but not least, there's also incredible overlap with the RAND Corporation, the Institute for Defense Analyses (IDA), SRI International, MITRE, and the Charles Stark Draper Laboratory. The JASON Group, of course, has been housed at IDA, the Stanford Research Institute and MITRE at various times. Some of its scientists are also part of the elite national security network. Of these groups, the RAND Corporation think tank is the most widely connected. Liberal establishment elites, national security scientists and scholars, neoconservative godfathers, persons moving into and out of the CIA - everybody's been on the board here over the years.

IDA and MITRE were part of the civilian national security network created by James Killian under President Eisenhower, who had the most Rockefeller-dominated presidency in American

history. The unusual thing about the MITRE Corporation is that it has been headed by a single person, James Schlesinger, for almost three decades now - since 1985. Another top elitist, Senator Chuck Robb, became a trustee in 2001 and has been vice chairman since 2006. Most likely Robb will take over from Schlesinger at some point. Leadership at IDA, a think tank, has switched much more often. Suzanne Woolsey, wife of James Woolsey, has headed the think tank since 2010.

SRI International was known as the Stanford Research Institute until 1975, when it split off from the university and became a private research institute. Certainly from the 1940s to about 1980 the institute was dominated by the Bechtels, CIA director John McCone, and, also in later years, by numerous Bohemian Grove friends. Tellingly, even William Perry briefly served as a director of SRI in the 1981-1983 period, in between government jobs. Perry was one of the men who stood at the basis of TRW, whose other founders could all be found at the Bechtel-dominated California Institute of Technology - Caltech. Historically Bechtel, SRI, Caltech, TRW and the Bohemian have had an *extremely* close connection. [42]

There's no doubt that this network has been involved in some of the most classified and certainly unusual defense projects of the Cold War. Project Stargate, the famous remote viewing program, was largely ran out at SRI from the 1970s to 1995, in coordination with SAIC. Those employed at SRI have included program director Hal Puthoff; Russell Targ, Ingo Swann and Joseph McMoneagle. Psychic Uri Geller and Richard "Mr. Cydonia" Hoagland could also be found here. All these men became instant hits at the famous radio show of Art Bell, today known as Coast to Coast AM, which is spewing out an endless stream of disinformation - with the help of the aforementioned persons. Seeing that the Bechtels and other Bohemian Grove elites were paying the bills at SRI, this evolution of affairs starts to make a little bit more sense.



Picture of the 1952 Washington, D.C. UFO sightings, taken from ISGP's somewhat hidden, but extremely valuable UFO section. Looking at the maneuvers reported in the newspapers and tracked on radar, it's hard not to be inspired to try and create technology on par with what was observed. As ISGP theorizes, nuclear power with various trusters (like a Harrier or F-35) should make it fairly easy for a large plane to gently move into and out of Earth's atmosphere and travel with tremendous speeds in space. Wouldn't that come in handy to explore the minerals on/in the Moon (helium 3) and Mars? We definitely can't keep fueling cars and space rockets conventional fuel as it running out in record time all over the world As for nuclear energy, nuclear planes were canceled in 1961. Nuclear rockets, with the 8' Phoebus 2B reactor producing an enormous 4,400 MW, were canceled in 1972. Expert agree that nuclear airplanes are possible today, but there's never any discussion about them, not even by the national security conservatives who never had any problems with the use of nuclear weapons. Nuclear rockets in the traditional sense may not even be necessary, now with Thorium and other potentially very interesting alternatives.

One interesting question to ponder is if any black programs exist in which revolutionary new energy devices have been developed. That's hard to say. It is strange that so much of this type of science and research is being ignored by governments and most of the mainstream media. Long laughed about, cold fusion seems to be a reality these days, as demonstrated by a device at MIT of professor Peter Hagelstein [43]; the E-Cat, which seems to be able to produce anywhere from 1,000 to 10,000 times as much energy as can be found in gasoline [44]; and other reports. [45]Energy generation by efficiently splitting water (H2O) into flammable hydrogen (H2) and oxygen (O), also long considered an impossibility, also seems to be a reality today. For example, the big business and primarily navy-backed BlackLight Power Corporation [46] is reported to have a working "Hydrino reactor". [47] The Sun Catalytix Corporation at MIT, financed by DARPA and since this time overseen by CIA elitist John Deutch, is working on a similar concept. [48] Elites are involved in other interesting projects. Lightbridge, formerly known as Thorium Power, has had Susan Eisenhower, Sir Ronald Grierson, Lord Guthie and Michael Howard on its board. [49] Thorium is a new, highly-efficient and non-polluting form of nuclear energy. It's an extremely promising form of energy. The Bloom Box fuel cell is another very interesting - yet less revolutionary - energy generation device, which has already been put to use by major Fortune 500 companies. Colin Powell, ranked high in ISGP's Superclass Index, like Deutch and John Lehman (linked to Blacklight), joined the board of Bloom Box. [50] Quite possibly the most important future energy of all, helium 3, to be used for nuclear fusion, seems to be largely ignored for now. The Moon has enormous supplies of this fuel, right at the surface. Peculiarly, one still has to look hard in order to find (reasonably) credible information on these devices that, with a peak in conventional should replace oil, gas and coal, need to be introduced as soon as possible. Whatever the reason, what is certain is that the development of these new energy technologies is closely monitored by the national security aspects of the establishment. And this same establishment is deeply linked to the oil and gas industry (including construction and maintenance): ExxonMobil, ChevronTexaco, BP, Shell, Halliburton, Schlumberger, Bechtel, etc.

In case of John Deutch, he can also be found at the National Petroleum Council with the executives of all major oil corporations; as well as the Secretary of Energy Advisory Board, along with Lockheed's Norman Augustine and top level defense industry insider William Perry. In 2006 John Deutch and MITRE/JASON head James Schlesinger (Superclass Index), another former CIA director, co-chaired the CFR's U.S. Oil Dependency Task Force. Former CIA director James Woolsey, the undisputed number two in ISGP's Superclass Index, is a co-founder of the United States Energy Security Council, in which George Shultz, William Perry, Norman Augustine and John Lehman are all involved; and served on the oil and gas industry-related Outer Continental Shelf Policy Committee (OCSPC). Woolsey is also very much concerned with alternative energy, although with less revolutionary energy devices as the ones just mentioned. Curiously, Woolsey, so closely linked to manipulating the UFO community through the Arlington Institute and the likes, has also been named a major player in the cover up of these alternative energy devices. Not by the most reliable source exactly, but most definitely a source Woolsey is acquainted with. [51]

Clearly this establishment group is very well informed of the situation in the world. It's next to impossible that they have not decided to promote research into alternative energy generation

devices, as within one or two decades these may become essential to the survival of western society. However, due to the fact that these same people are close to the oil and gas industry, there's a good chance that these devices will not be promoted until the effects of the oil peak begin to cripple the West's economy. Do black programs exist in which these type of energy devices already exist? It's possible. All that would have been needed is a team of top notch engineers with an open mind to start making breakthroughs. But at the same time persons like Steven Greer may be manipulating the conspiracy community (which he is certainly doing) to boost interest in potential alternative energy devices. As Greer is a product of the sameestablishment managing these programs, this most certainly is a possibility.

Much more can be written about the defense industry aspect, but it is recommended that readers themselves take a look at the names and corporations listed in the <u>index of institutes defense section</u>, or search for the names that appear in ISGP's <u>Superclass Index</u> section labeled '<u>Top DOD</u> scientists'.

Quick notes on Russia



1993, Russia's face of "democracy": Yeltsin with his long-time security chief, General Alexander Korzhakov (behind him), and defense secretary from 1992 to 1996, General Pavel Grachev (to his left). These two men were the leaders of the military "siloviki" faction in this period. In order to prevent a possible coup from the military, Yeltsin allowed top military leaders to fill their pockets any way they could. Grachev in particular seems to have been involved in anything from the drug trade to the illegal sell off of Russian arms. His group pushed for the 1st Chechen War (over Caspian Sea oil control), gave orders to the Far West group, and hated the oligarchs and economic reformers. Tellingly, he and "Party of War" ally Sergei Stepashin were quoted saying during a drunk press conference at the time of the first Chechen campaign:


"[Grachev:] Seventeen-year-old boys are dying with happy smiles on their faces ... [Stepashin:] And now our air force is carrying out the whole program, paying no mind to the peacemakers in Moscow, isn't that right, Pavel Sergeyevich [Grachev]?" [55]

Yeltsin was forced to fire Korzhakov, Grachev and other allies in 1996 in order to get support from the oligarchs which controlled the main TV channels and the economy at that point.


A 50,000 word article on Russia's power structures has largely been finished, but not published due to time constraints. Simply put, Russia has the (since Yeltsin largely ignored) <u>traditional think tank elite</u>; the oligarchs, with a dominant Zionist element during the Yeltsin years; Putin's more nationalist "Petersburgers", and, certainly during the first Yeltsin term, an ultra-right-wing military "siloviki" aspect, represented by such men as defense minister Pavel Grachev and security head General Alexander Korzhakov. For the most part Putin has suppressed all other

establishments, including the Zionist-oriented Solntsevskaya mafia that has been particularly close with many oligarchs and some think tank elitists.

In 2000 Putin and his St. Petersburg friends quickly took control of companies that included ORT (media), NTV (media), Gazprom and Rosneft. Seemingly always overlooked are the defense corporations. A key one is the United Aircraft Corporation, which, since 2006, controls famous military aircraft builders Sukhoi, MiG and Tupolev: "St. Petersburger" Sergei Ivanov was put in as chairman. Another key firm is Almaz-Antey, producer of the world's most dangerous anti-aircraft SAM missile sites: the S-300, S-400 and S-500: "St. Petersburger" Viktor Ivanov was appointed chairman in 2002. In 2002 Putin also ordered the restructuring of Mashinostroyenia, developer of the hypersonic Oniks/Yakhont, BrahMos and BrahMos II cruise missiles that form an extreme threat to American war ships, most notably to aircraft carriers. Oniks reaches speeds of Mach 2.5, the improved BrahMos flies at Mach 3 and the stealthy BrahMos II is expected to reach a speed of no less than Mach 7. The Oniks alone forms such a threat to U.S. warships that in July 2013 Israel attacked a Syrian warehouse where newly-arrived Russian missiles were alleged to be stored.



U.S. GDP was three to four times higher than the Soviet Union's throughout the Cold War. Still, total defense expenditure was roughly the same after 46 years of Cold War. Is it any wonder the Soviet Union collapsed? Even today with the War on Terror the U.S. spends only about 4.5-5 percent of its GDP (not the annual budget) on the military. Russia was spending anywhere from 15 percent to as high as 27 when it tried to keep up with the Reagan administration. Russia's economy collapsed even more during the 1990s, having its 10 year "robber baron" period, followed by Putin who has been building a legitimate economy, albeit still overly reliant of oil and gas prices. Most oligarchs are still in place. They have just been forced to pay their taxes and stay out of politics.



Persons involved in Russia's economic reforms. The group within Russia was all Jewish. They were the most reliable and

determined dissenters to the Soviet system. Even before Yeltsin picked them up, they were in touch with British aristocratic economists and MI6 assets. Contacts with the Rockefeller group in the U.S. soon followed. The latter controlled the Harvard Institute for International Development, which tried to advise reformers as Yegor Gaidar and Anatoly Chubais. However, Yeltsin's new economists handed over all of Russia's key economic and media assets to fellow Zionists, as well as non-Jewish buddies of Yeltsin. Total anarchy ensued. Opposing nationalist and Zionist elements around a perpetually drunk president tore the country to pieces, with the liberal dream of a "New World Order," a democratic Russia allied with the West, quickly evaporating.

Russia's S-400 seems to be the best anti-aircraft system in the world by a long shot: 400 km range and at closer range at least limited ability to detect stealth aircraft. The upcoming S-500 is an advanced anti-ICBM system. In terms of anti-aircraft and anti-ballistic missile defense, as well as anti-ship missiles, Russia is ahead of the West. Guaranteeing the safety of carrier battle groups and even stealth aircraft in Central Asia might become a major challenge in the future.

Putin prefers to work with the West, but his insistence on rebuilding the military, the competition for Central Asian resources, and his anti-democratic tendencies, make an alliance with the West nearly impossible. But the fact is, for the Russian people, Putin is the better choice, at least when compared to the hated oligarchs. They will economically corrupt and ruin the country as they did in the 1990s. The problem is, the weaker Russia is - at least militarily - the better it is for the West. Even more so in a world with dwindling natural resources. The last thing the West prefers is to be even more dependent on Russian oil and mineral exports. But as long as the oligarchs are out of power and Russia has a strong military, there's little the West can do about that. The only alternative seems to be mass production of E-Cats and related energy devices.

Update: Just months after finishing up this article a dispute arose between the West and Russia over the Ukraine. Russia has been pressing Ukrainian president Viktor Yanukovych to back out of treaties with the European Union. In turn the West, with persons from ISGP's Superclass Index leading the process, has been backing pro-EU protests in the country against Yanukovych, even openly embracing fascist/Nazi opposition to Russian influence in the form of Oleh Tyahnybok (who met with the controversial national security senator John McCain, a reported contact of the <u>shady Far West black operations firm</u>, among many other things). Western media and political circles don't have one friendly word to say about Putin. In fact, it seems it has literally become sacrilige to say even the slighest positive or unbiased word about Putin. The Cold War is raging in considerable force again.

The bottom line

Whatever establishment we are talking about, in the end a lot comes down to class warfare. All establishments will be hostile to (genuine) socialist politics and its persistent support for labor unions and the rights of the lower and middle classes. The more radical form of socialism, communism, has been the most acute threat throughout most of the 20th century and all four (western) establishments have been doing their best to either contain or eradicate it. And also in Russia the wealthy are always conspiring against the lower classes.



Former prime minister Dries van Agt, once explained that Dutch political parties have a tendency to settle their differences behind the scenes. ISGP is inclined to believe that the establishments surrounding the Atlantic interact in similar manner:

"After a certain amount of debate agreements are made. Then it is obvious of course that those in power, the involved ministers, usually together with the party leaders - in meetings where outsiders are not present - will agree on how they will behave in congressional debates. Often it even goes so far that they are discussing the likely motions of the opposition - the ones that will be acceptable and the ones that will not be. They will also discuss how each party can save face as much as possible in these discussions. Usually it is already arranged what party can demand something from the government. The change has already been laid ready. ... There's very little room for individual action." [52]

When it comes to establishments, the impression that ISGP has increasingly been having is that important issues are discussed behind the scenes while the media are used to sell the ideas of one of these establishments to the public - or to surreptitiously undermine the policies of another establishment. The constant bickering between liberal pro-detente and conservative anti-detente forces, between liberal anti-SDI and conservative pro-SDI groups during the Cold War is a great example of that. In both cases think tank personnel and politicians tied to one of these establishments used the media to basically sway public opinion in their favor - often by trying to come across as "nonpartisan". But at the same time key persons in these establishments interacted with each other in the backrooms of corporations, think tanks and socials clubs. It appears that it is in these backrooms that limits are being set on what can and can't be discussed in public. The Kennedy assassination and 9/11 are ultimate examples of that. Because all establishments were involved in those conspiracies to an extent, and likely also because it would undermine the continued existence of every other establishment, absolutely no one has been allowed to dig into these events, not even to (seriously) implicate an opposing establishment. Compare this to the New York Times, Washington Post and Time magazine once in while exposing CIA wrongdoing, which at least in some cases appears to have been an effort to curb conservative CIA-linked forces in the White House.

The conspiracy movement has generally been manipulated along similar lines. On the liberal side there has been Daniel Sheehan's group. Hobnobbing with State Department elites as George Shultz, Zbigniew Brzezinski and the Rockefellers, it was Sheehan who was responsible for exposing the drug trafficking activities of Shackley's CIA group and its activities of trying to capture the presidency. At the same time he and his associates, like crop circle researcher Colin Andrews and Dr. Steven Greer, other associates of Laurance Rockefeller, have been religiously promoting catastrophic global warning theories. Ask Sheehan about the Kennedy assassination or 9/11 and all of sudden he doesn't believe in any major establishment-ran conspiracies anymore. Gee, I wonder why. Maybe because those are the ones he's working for.



The wonderful John Birchers and the Liberty Lobby who always brought us info on the CFR, Bilderberg and the liberal establishment, hated the left-wing Kennedy. Picture 3: Carol Rosin, prominent in the disinformation-riddled Disclosure Project, and a major anti-SDI campaigner with many other curious links. Sheehan, lawyer for both Laurance Rockefeller and the Disclosure Project, helped run the State of the World Forum, visited by leading Trilateralists and Bilderbergers, in part to create a new world religion. Sheehan was the one who exposed Iran-Contra drug trafficking of Ted Shackley's "secret team". Not for you, the small man, but for friends like Henry Kissinger, George Shultz and Zbigniew Brzezinski who wanted to curb the influence of William Casey's spooks on President Ronald Reagan. These three were among the visitors of the State of the World Forum, financed by David Rockefeller, the Rockefeller Foundation, Ted Turner and even UFO cultist Joe Firmage, a James Woolsey associate who financed the work of Robert and Ryan Wood on the MJ-12 documents and has also been represented by Sheehan. Yes, even the conspiracy community and New Age scene are dominated by various establishments. That's the whole purpose why I didn't completely do away with my site.

On the conservative side the John Birch Society, the Liberty Lobby and its various descendants have been beating the anti-United Nations, anti-CFR, anti-Bilderberg and anti-global warming theory drum. Seeing how especially the John Birch Society was interlocked with Western Goals and the top-level American Security Council, does one really think the John Birchers or the Liberty Lobby ever represented the "small man"? No, they didn't. They never went after the Kennedy assassination or 9/11, except when they could pin minor aspects on "liberals" or "Zionists". Why? Maybe because MacArthur's fascist generals and Shackley's CIA colleagues were running these organizations, some of whom, including Shackley himself, having been tied to the assassination. You're not safe either in Great Britain. Look at Lord Monckton, a superhero in the conspiracy movement for his paper 35 Inconvenient Truths and willingness to challenge Al Gore's global warming theories in public. Just check out his family history I would say. It's a tale of Pilgrims Society and Knights of Malta members, of MI6 station chiefs, the mercenary firm Defence Systems Limited and government assassins as Stephan Kock.

I suggest you tread carefully outside the walls of ISGP: counter-intelligence is a huge pain in the ass. This site is meant to be a safe-haven for all those interested in getting solid answers on conspiracy topics without you having to spent literally your entire life trying to sort fact from fiction.

Pressure: "Too many people have been spied upon by too many government agencies and too much information has been collected," said the report, which noted that over the last twenty years the FBI alone had conducted nearly 1 million domestic security investigations resulting in 500,000 permanent files but not one prosecution for subversion since 1957. In some cases, the probes were prompted by political pressure from Presidents since Franklin Roosevelt; Dwight Eisenhower received political intelligence on such obvious non-threats as Eleanor Roosevelt, Bernard Baruch and Supreme Court Justice William O. Douglas. The vague standards for surveillance secretly set by the agencies themselves also led to widespread investigation-and often harassment-of citizens simply on the basis of their political beliefs and life-styles. ... The Church committee also proposed barring intimidation of citizens such agencies as the IRS, which focused special audits on activits, and the FBI-which used its COINTELPRO techniques to try to discredit Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Disseminating information to undercut a person's reputation, job or marriage would be barred by law rather than by the consciences of intelligence officials.

'Cover': As explained by CIA sources and outside investigators, many agency proprietaries were developed over the years to provide cover" for agents on foreign assignments. They included airlines, public-relations firms, private security services, even travel publications such - at one time - as the Fodor guidebooks, it was reported last week. Agents also infiltrated existing U.S. organizations such as labor unions and the National Student Association. While that practice was supposedly terminated after the revelations of the mid-'60s, some sources said the agency had withdrawn only from groups that had been compromised. Beyond that, the CIA regularly lends agents to other arms of government - the Secret Service and Drug Enforcement Administration, for example - and it generally enjoys the sympathy of agency alumni (some perhaps still on the payroll) working in other critical positions. For example, NEWSWEEK learned, the Assistant Postmaster General in charge of domesticmail surveillance went directly there from the CIA. ... Most prominent of these was James J. Angleton, chief of counterintelligence, who resigned a fortnight ago after being linked to the illegal domestic surveillance (NEWSWEEK, Jan. 6). Last week, Angleton's three top aides at CIA also resigned, raising even more questions about the section's past activities. Entries: Angleton and his aides had not been solely responsible for CIA excesses in domestic surveillance. NEWSWEEK learned that at least some of the questionable conduct was attributable to the agency's Office of Security, whose former director, Howard Osborne, also retired suddenly last year - reportedly after some of his

Congressional testimony proved disturbing to Colby. His section was responsible for the security of CIA buildings, personnel and records, and also operated as the agency's internal police force - making literally thousands of investigators of citizens who came into contact with the CIA through employment applications or proprietary organizations. It was the security office that made one of the illegal entries to which the CIA admits - to recover classified documents that veteran agent Hans Tofte had carelessly left around his Washington home. Under the Directorate of Operations, an agency euphemism for clandestine services and "dirty tricks," are two units besides Angleton's whose domestic activities could easily cross the line of legality. One is the Domestic Operations Division, ostensibly responsible mainly for recruiting and for interviewing travelers returned from abroad. Actually, this division has also been infiltrating outside groups, sotting up agency proprietaries or fronts and keeping track of most citizens with whom its agents came into contact. Another center of domestic activity is Division D (formerly called Staff D), which handles intelligence relating to communications. That includes "bag jobs" aimed at getting at getting foreign diplomatic codes and some opening of mail to and from U.S. citizens. In San Diego last week, former CIA staffer Mel Crain - now a political-science professor - said he operated under Staff D authority for such a mail-opening operation in the late 1950s. Mail from U.S. citizens to countries behind the Iron Curtain was scientifically opened, copied and resealed without a trace, Crain said. The CIA was reportedly prompted to take on increasingly broad domestic responsibilities in the 1960s as Presidents Kennedy, Johnson and Nixon grew increasingly dissatisfied with the work of J. Edgar Hoover's FBI. The big break came in 1970 over an incident in which the CIA refused to tell Hoover the name of an FBI agent who had given the CIA some useful information. In a rage, Hoover abruptly abolished a seven-man liaison office through which the FBI had traditionally dealt with the larger U.S. intelligence community. Slack: That left the agency more on its own than ever. Without the FBI to handle the domestic end of counterespionage investigations, for example, Angleton relied more heavily on the CIA Office of Security and perhaps the Domestic Operations Division. Some sources said he took up the slack with a special 50-man unit within his own CI section. That unit, which apparently dated to 1968, was directed by career intelligence officer Richard Ober, now a staffer at the National Security Council (though still on the CIA payroll, he concedes). And it was Ober who was originally named as the man responsible for briefing former CIA director Richard Helms on the progress of the domestic-surveillance program, which reportedly flourished under Helm's administration. Helms, now the ambassador to Iran, was sure to face strenuous questioning on the whole controversy. Back in the U.S. last week for home leave after a brief vacation in Europe, he was quickly summoned to a breakfast with Secretary of State Kissinger and then met with President Ford. Helms was also expected to testify on Capitol Hill, where the question of perjury has been raised in connection with his numerous denials of illegal CIA domestic surveillance. She served as JINSA's executive director from 1981 to 1991 and is credited with transforming the organization from a small think tank into a player in the Washington conservative scene. She later took charge of issues relating to defense policies and was the main author of the group's reports and position papers. Bryen's blunt analysis of the Middle East gave her a reputation as a hawkish straight shooter, short on nuance and willing to take on the conventional wisdom. For instance, she opposed talks with the Palestine Liberation

Organization even when negotiations were endorsed by a Republican administration; even now, defying much of the rhetoric of supporters of Benjamin Netanyahu's government, she thinks an Israeli attack on Iran is unlikely. It is this style that, according to a key JINSA lay leader, got Bryen in trouble. Accounts provided to the Forward by board members and individuals close to the organization, speaking on condition of anonymity because of the personal nature of the dispute, portrayed a tense relationship between Bryen and JINSA's president, David Ganz, a successful Boston businessman who is also the group's largest single donor. The two have sparred over issues relating to JINSA's future and the focus of its programs. Officials involved with the group said that Ganz viewed Bryen's direct style and her open opposition to decisions made by the board as problematic."

Swartz has invented a palladium-based device he names a NANOR. When an electric current is passed through the palladium, excess energy in the form of heat is produced which, according to Hagelstein, is over 14 times the input energy. In this talk, Hagelstein says that this NANOR has been running at MIT since January, and it has continued to produce excess heat far beyond anything that could be accounted for by a chemical reaction. Hagelstein says that the public is invited to take a look at the device in action. As we have come to expect these days, there has been very little reporting of this development outside a few blogs on the Internet. It would be interesting if some of Hagelstein's peers at MIT would take a look at the NANOR and make some comments or even if some outside experts could pay a visit. Hagelstein's talk can be seen in the video below his presentation starts at around the 52 minute point."

In return the Pilot Customer agrees upon Scheduled Installation time by late fall 2013. Hydro Fusion to use the Pilot Plant as a Showcase where external customers can be introduced to an ECAT 1 MW in operation. Hydro Fusion is open to any type of heat application given the restriction of a maximum 120 C temperature."" In other words, Hydro Fusion is offering an E-Cat for no cost ... the lucky winner will pay only for the energy produced at, presumably, parity with the cost of traditional energy sources. ... What a COP of 6 means is that the device outputs 6 times the energy put into it so for every kilowatt of electrical energy input the E-Cat on offer will output 6 kW of heat (a net gain of 5kW) which is a very impressive. But what's really interesting is that the Hydro Fusion installation is intended to become a showcase, a presumably public demonstration with a real customer who will soon know if the E-Cat performs as claimed. Alas, if you're inclined to offer your company as a host for this project there's a footnote to the release: "As the funding comes with particular restrictions, Hydro Fusion is unable to consider offers from outside of Sweden. Thank you for those offers already made from around the world.""

That is the most powerful energy source known to man," researcher Michael McKubre told 60 Minutes correspondent Scott Pelley. McKubre says he has seen that energy more than 50 times in cold fusion experiments he's doing at SRI International, a respected California lab that does extensive work for the government. McKubre is an electro-chemist who imagines, in 20 years, the creation of a clean nuclear battery. "For example, a laptop would come pre-charged with all of the energy that you would ever intend to use. You're now decoupled from your charger and the wall socket," he explained. The same would go for cars. "The potential is for an energy source that would run your car for three, four years, for example. And you'd take it in for service every four years and they'd give you a new power supply," McKubre told Pelley. "Power stations?" Pelley asked. "You can imagine a one for one plug in replacement for nuclear fuel rods. And the difference only would be that at the end of the lifetime of that fuel rod, you didn't have radioactive waste that needed to be disposed of," McKubre replied. He showed 60 Minutes just how simple the experiment looks; there are only three main ingredients. First, there is palladium, a metal in the platinum family. Second, one needs a kind of hydrogen called deuterium which is found in seawater. "Deuterium is essentially unlimited. There is ten times as much energy in a gallon of sea water, from the deuterium contained within it, than there is in a gallon of gasoline," he explained. The palladium is placed in water containing deuterium and the third ingredient is an electric current. The experiment is wrapped in insulation and instruments. They're looking for what they call "excess heat." In other words, is more energy coming out than the electric current puts in? No one knows exactly how excess heat would be generated, but McKubre showed 60 Minutes what he thinks is happening. At the atomic level, palladium looks like a lattice and the electricity drives the deuterium to the palladium. "They sit on the surface and they pop inside the lattice," he explained, using an artist's rendition of the lattice. McKubre believes there is a nuclear reaction - possibly a fusion process like what happens in the sun, but occurring inside the metal, at a slower rate, and without dangerous radiation. Scientists today like to call it a nuclear effect rather than

cold fusion. At least 20 labs working independently have published reports of excess heat - heat up to 25 times greater than the electricity going in. "This little piece of palladium metal has about a third as much energy as the battery in your automobile. So very small volumes, very small masses can produce large amounts of energy," he explained, holding a small piece of palladium foil weighing just 0.3 grams. McKubre has been working on this since that first discredited claim of cold fusion made headlines 20 years ago. "To work on this issue is almost to put your scientific credibility at risk and I wonder why you've done it?" Pelley asked. "My belief is that if there's a one percent chance that Fleischmann and Pons were correct, and I now believe that possibility is 99 percent. I have a duty to work on it," he replied. Martin Fleischmann and Stanley Pons amazed the world in 1989 with their cold fusion news conference at the University of Utah. Fleischmann in particular was one of the world's leading electro-chemists, and the announcement of room temperature fusion set the world on fire."

The discovery is useful in any need for electric power. "Specifically, BlackLight has developed a commercially competitive, nonpolluting source of energy that forms a predicted, previously undiscovered, more stable form of hydrogen called "Hydrino" that releases two hundred times more energy than burning hydrogen, enabling ubiquitous H2O vapor to serve as the source of H2 [hydrogen] fuel," a press release on BLP's elegant Web site says. The "extraordinary claim" met extraordinary tests, according to Prof. Henry Weinberg of the renowned California University of Technology. "It would be irrational not to be very skeptical," Dr. Weinberg said, and I was extremely skeptical. However, after having reviewed Dr. Mills classical theory, participated in experimental designs and execution, and having reviewed vast amounts of other data BLP produced, I have found nothing that warrants rejection of their extraordinary claims, and I encourage aggressive optimization and fast track development of a scaled up prototype," said Dr. Weinberg. "To be able to use hydrogen from water as a cheap and nonpolluting source of power would represent one of the most important technological breakthroughs in history." "BLP has developed an electrochemical cell, the catalyst induced hydrino transition cell (CIHT), to harness this energy as direct electrical output," said a research report by Dr. James K. Pugh, director of technology for the the Enser Corporation, which helps small companies move prototypes to mass production. The scientists who undertook the validation studies, some "extremely skeptical" at the outset of their tests, found themselves convinced in each case, a review of the reports show. The results validate the lifelong and much-maligned research of MIT and Harvard Medical School graduate Randell Mills, PhD., who has often been derided and ridiculed for the "Grand Unified Theory" of classical and quantum physics that he proposes to explain his theories. Quantum physicists have steadfastly ignored or pilloried Mills' theories and research. His Grand Unified Theory, self-published last July, relies on laws of physics and classical principles, not pure mathematics, as quantum scientists do. Weinberg says Mills' approach is "far simpler and more accurate than sophisticated quantum mathematical observations [and] has been controversial, of course." Now, though, extensive research has refuted the criticism of quantum mathematicians. "As a direct result of this theory, Dr.

Mills has been able to calculate, with great precision, bond energies and molecular structures that have been verified through experimental observation and reported in the literatrure," MIT scientist Terry Copeland said in his study of the theory and the hydrino power device. "BLP has achieved a historic success for a technology that could be commercialized as an alternative form of power generation. Potential applications range from stationary power infrastructure including the large scale electric grid to to distributed and microdistributed scales and motive fuels infrastructure. The promise will ultimately be driven by economics." Copeland said. Ironically, it was MIT scientists who took the lead in debunking the original discovery of Pons and Fleischmann, but today MIT professor Peter Hagelstein has been demonstrating a working cold fusion tabletop device open to the public at Bldg. 36 on the MIT campus in Cambridge, Mass. Based on an independent evaluation, The American Reporter reported positively on developments in hydrino research last year for both this publication and the iReport section of CNN. There has been little activity on the BlackLight Power Web site since then, and many doubters and skeptics believed the company was in its death throes. Today's reports, however, present a far different picture. The privately-owned company is headquartered in Cranbury, N.J., a half hour from the Princeton and Edison, N.J., labs of inventors Albert Einstein and Thomas Edison, to whom many would now compare Mills. A report on the hydrino reactor by MIT scientist Terry Copeland, PhD., said a 10-watt demonstration model should be "achievable near term", and 100-watt, 1,000-watt and larger systems would follow that, Goodwin suggested. The invention of a "bipolar plate" that allows power output to be scaled up was key to the commercial viability of the reactors, Copeland said. The company said a 1.5 kW plant to power the average-size home should be operational in 2013, it said. BLP has failed to meet deadlines for demonstrations in the past, but the devices demonstrated in December and January by the reporting scientists - in some cases as they watched their construction - seem capable of reaching that goal. "BLP has successfully fabricated and tested CIHT cells capable of producing net electrical output up to 50 times that input to maintain the process," according to Dr. Copeland, who has served as a product development specialist for DuPont and Duracell. "Some cells have produced steady power for over one month. The power generation is consistent with Dr. Mills' theory of energy release resulting from Hydrino formation. No other source of energy could be identified. "The CIHT cell will use cheap, abundant, nontoxic, commodity chemicals, with no apparent long-term supply issues that might preclude commercial, high volume manufacturing," Copekland added. "The capital cost of the CIHT cell based on optimization of the cell dimensions is estimated to be under \$100/kW compared to at least ten times that for fuel cells that further require a source of hydrogen or hydrogen gas and a fuel infrastructure." "Specifically," BlackLight announced on its Web site, "BlackLight has developed a commercially competitive, nonpolluting source of energy that forms a predicted, previously undiscovered, more stable form of hydrogen called "Hydrino" that releases two hundred times more energy than burning hydrogen, enabling ubiquitous H2O vapor to serve as the source of H2 fuel." In plain words, Mills has managed to use electrolysis of water - a process developed by Thomas Caryle and Alessandro Volta in 1800 - to produce electricity in addition to breaking down the constituent elements of water, oxygen

and hydrogen. The most obvious applications would be for home power generators and electric automobile engines. The relatively simple apparatus would produce the energy at about a tenth of the cost of current systems, such as coal-fired, nuclear, geothermal and hydroelectric plants. Mills was somewhat of a pariah in the chemical and research world even as he raised \$70 million from venture capitalists - some of them among the largest and best-known - in the late 1990s and early part of this decade. The current head of the Dept. of Energy, Dr. Stephen Chu, was quoted in the Village Voice in 2001 saying, "I wouldn't invest" in Mills efforts, which have consumed Mills ever since the announcement in March 1989 of tabletop cold fusion by Dr. Stanley Pons and Henry Fleischmann at the University of Utah. Mills is also noted for a number of useful inventions in the medical engineering field, and for Millsian, a software that identifies constituent properties of complex molecules. At the same time as today's announcement from BlackLight, the Pons-Fleischmann cold fusion research is also being validated by at least five companies hoping to bring a product to market for home heating and electrical power generation using cold fusion, although only one, Leonardo Corp. of Miami, Fla., has so far done so. Cold fusion, now known as "low energy nuclear reactions," or LENR, is not the basis for Mills' work, however. The relevance of it is that America may soon see electrical power systems that vastly reduce the cost of using electricity in any form, making possible a vast new infusion of cash and energy into a weakened economy. "If this [CIHT] technology is proved and developed to its full potential, then hydrogen from water could be used as a fuel source to provide a cheap, abundant, and non-polluting energy source to meet future energy demands," one study by an unnamed Fortune 500 defense-related company reported. The same company is testing 11 more cells under highly secure conditions and will also produce a report on those, it said. Due to the lateness of the hour, Dr. Mills could not be reached for comment."

Well over 100 start-ups in Silicon Valley are working on it, and one of them, Bloom Energy, is about to make public its invention: a little power plant-in-a-box they want to put literally in your backyard. You'll generate your own electricity with the box and it'll be wireless. The idea is to one day replace the big power plants and transmission line grid, the way the laptop moved in on the desktop and cell phones supplanted landlines. It has a lot of smart people believing and buzzing, even though the company has been unusually secretive - until now. K.R. Sridhar invited "60 Minutes" correspondent Lesley Stahl for a first look at the innards of the Bloom box that he has been toiling on for nearly a decade. Looking at one of the boxes, Sridhar told Stahl it could power an average U.S. home. "The way we make it is in two blocks. This is a European home. The two put together is a U.S. home," he explained. "'Cause we use twice as much energy, is that what you're saying?" Stahl asked. "Yeah, and this'll power four Asian homes," he replied. ... He says he knows it works because he originally invented a similar device for NASA. He really is a rocket scientist. "This invention, working on Mars, would have allowed the NASA administrator to pick up a phone and say, 'Mr. President, we know how to produce oxygen on Mars," Sridhar told Stahl. "So this was going to produce oxygen so people could actually live on Mars?" she asked. "Absolutely," Sridhar replied. When NASA scrapped that Mars mission, Sridhar had an idea: he reversed his Mars machine. Instead of it making oxygen, he pumped oxygen in. He invented a new kind of fuel cell, which is like a very skinny battery that always runs. Sridhar feeds oxygen to it on one side, and fuel on the other. The two combine within the cell to create a chemical reaction

that produces electricity. There's no need for burning or combustion, and no need for power lines from an outside source. ... One thing stoking his skepticism: Sridhar has been hyper-secretive - there's no sign on his building, a cryptic Web site, and no public progress reports. Given the stealthiness, we were surprised when Sridhar showed us - for the very first time - how he makes the "secret sauce" of his fuel cell on the cheap. He said he bakes sand and cuts it into little squares that are turned into a ceramic. Then he coats it with green and black "inks" that he developed. Sridhar told Stahl there is a secret formula. "And you take that and you apply that. You paint that on either side of this white ceramic to get a green layer and a black layer. And ... that's it." Sridhar told Stahl the finished product, a skinny fuel cell, would generate power. One disk powers one light bulb; the taller the stack of disks, the more power it generates. In between each disk there's a metal plate, but instead of platinum, Sridhar uses a cheap metal alloy. The stacks are the heart of the Bloom box: put 64 of them together and you get something big enough to power a Starbucks. Sridhar offered to give Stahl a sneak peek inside the Bloom box. "All those modules that we saw go into this big box. Fuel goes in, air goes in, out comes electricity," he explained. ... Asked if Bloom box is intended to get rid of the grid, John Doerr told Stahl, "The Bloom box is intended to replace the grid...for its customers. It's cheaper than the grid, it's cleaner than the grid." "Now, won't the utility companies see this as a threat and try to crush Bloom?" Stahl asked. "No, I think the utility companies will see this as a solution," Doerr said. "All they need to do is buy Bloom boxes, put them in the substation for the neighborhood and sell that electricity and operate." "They'll buy these boxes?" Stahl asked. "They buy nuclear power plants. They buy gas turbines from General Electric," he pointed out. To make power, you'd still need fuel. Many past fuel cells failed because they needed expensive pure hydrogen. Not this box. "Our system can use fossil fuels like natural gas. Our system can use renewable fuels like landfill gas, biogas," Sridhar told Stahl. "We can use solar." "You know, it's very difficult for us to come in here and make an evaluation. How are we supposed to know whether what you're saying is true?" Stahl asked. "Why don't we talk to our first customers?" he replied. Yes, he already has customers. Twenty large, well-known companies have quietly bought and are testing Bloom boxes in California. Like FedEx. We were at their hub in Oakland, the day Bloom installed their boxes, each one costing \$700-800,000. One reason the companies have signed up is that in California 20 percent of the cost is subsidized by the state, and there's a 30 percent federal tax break because it's a "green" technology. In other words: the price is cut in half. "We have FedEx, we have Walmart," Sridhar explained. He told Stahl the first customer was Google. Four units have been powering a Google datacenter for 18 months. They use natural gas, but half as much as would be required for a traditional power plant. ... John Donahoe, eBay's CEO, says its five boxes were installed nine months ago and have already saved the company more than \$100,000 in electricity costs. "It's been very successful thus far. They've done what they said they would do," he told Stahl. eBay's boxes run on bio-gas made from landfill waste, so they're carbon neutral. Donahoe took us up to the roof to show off the company's more than 3,000 solar panels. But they generate a lot less electricity than the boxes on the lawn. "So this, on five buildings, acres and acres and acres," Stahl remarked. "Yes. The footprint for Bloom is much more efficient," Donahoe said. "When you average it over seven days a
