What Jesuit trained President Donald J. Trump did is clearly **Blasphemy: Blasphemy** in the Greek means: When one "switches" right for wrong (wrong for right), i.e. calls what God *disapproves*, "*right*" and Calls what God approves of as "wrong or bad" -- which "exchanges the Truth of God for a lie, Isaiah 5:20; Romans 1:25 -- whereas man worships and serves the creature (Mary), i.e.: one created, or if one would worships creation, such as "Mother Earth" or ANYTHING or anyone instead of God through the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth, Galatians 6:15; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Mark 16:15; Colossians 1:12-23; Romans 8:21-22."

Matthew 12:46-50; Luke 11:27-28; Isaiah 42:8

If Mary was sinless herself, she would need no Saviour, Luke 1:46-48; Romans 3:23. Instead, Mary makes a declaration thanking God for Saving her from her sins. (All Salvation throughout all history had to wait for the Cross of Calvary, including Mary's. All Old Testament Saints were not Saved, they would not be made **perfect (Whole or complete before God)** without us -- i.e.: without all the New Testament Saints, Hebrews 11:40; Hebrews 11:1-40. Why, why did everyone's Salvation both Old and New Testaments Saints have to wait for the Cross of Calvary? As Christ Jesus the Saviour made ONE Sacrifice for sin for all times, for all the Saints of God in Both the Old and New Testaments, **not the bloodless re-sacrifice done over and over again by a satanic 'priest' pretending transubstantiation as they do in the satanic Roman Catholic Mass . . . for without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of one's sins,** Hebrews 9:22:

In all of Holy Scripture, the Holy Bible, the Lord Jesus Christ never called Mary His mother. Jesus always refers to her as "woman" to show his distance from her, although he loved her and respected her, Christ Jesus minimized her by never calling her mother.

Even at the Cross of Calvary the Lord Jesus Christ still called Mary woman:

John 19:16-27

16 Then delivered he him therefore unto them to be crucified. And they took Jesus, and led him away.

17 And he bearing his cross went forth into a place called the place of a skull, which is called in the Hebrew Golgotha:

18 Where they crucified him, and two other with him, on either side one, and Jesus in the midst.

19 And Pilate wrote a title, and put it on the cross. And the writing was JESUS OF NAZARETH THE KING OF THE JEWS.

20 This title then read many of the Jews: for the place where Jesus was crucified was nigh to the city: and it was written in Hebrew, and Greek, and Latin.

21 Then said the chief priests of the Jews to Pilate, Write not, The King of the Jews; but that he said, I am King of the Jews.

22 Pilate answered, What I have written I have written.

23 Then the soldiers, when they had crucified Jesus, took his garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also his coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout.

24 They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the scripture might be fulfilled, which saith, They parted my raiment among them, and for my vesture they did cast lots. These things therefore the soldiers did.

25 Now there stood by the cross of Jesus his mother, and his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Cleophas, and Mary Magdalene.

26 When Jesus therefore saw his mother, and the disciple standing by, whom he loved, **he saith unto his mother, Woman, behold thy son!**

27 Then saith he to the disciple, Behold thy mother! And from that hour that disciple took her unto his own home.

God the Father, God The Son--the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth, and God the Holy Ghost make up one God as three individual men, Deuteronomy 6:4-5; Matthew 22:37-39; Mark 12:28-30; Matthew 28:18-20. There is no female,

there is no God other than the Holy Trinity. The Son Of God, Christ Jesus, is glorified alone (not along with Mary or any other created creature) by God the Father by giving Christ Jesus a name above EVERY name:
