

# **We are Commanded to pray for all of our leaders, so that we can live a quite and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.**

## **1 Timothy 2:1-6**

1 I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men;

2 For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty.

3 For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour;

4 Who will have **all** men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.

**Note:** Are ALL men Saved? No. So either God cannot do His Will (and thus is NOT God,) or we have to study to find out what is meant.

This word **all** can certainly mean everyone at every time who has ever lived, but it does not. We see this word **all** to harmonized all of Holy Scripture the Holy Bible thus means:

**as many as, pás ("each, every") means "all" in the sense of**

**"each (every) part that applies."** Thus, the part to whom it applies is **all** those Chosen by God before the foundation of the world, .The emphasis of the total picture then is on "one piece at a time." 365 (*ananeóō*) then focuses on the *part(s)* **making up the whole – viewing the whole in terms of the individual parts.**

**So, are ALL men Saved? No.** This word **all** then means only those to whom it applies, each and every part of a group Called by God, His Elect. It has been so from the beginning, declared by God to Moses:

## **Exodus 20:6**

6 And shewing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments.

**God never said He would Save All; God's Word was to many, not all; we do not know whom the Elect are, but are under Command to Preach the Gospel to every creature (every person) who will receive it:**

Matthew 20:16; Matthew 20:28; Matthew 26:28; Matthew 7:21-23

**So are **all** going to be Saved? No.**

### **Mark 16:15-16**

15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; **but he that believeth not shall be damned.**

**Note:** Baptism does NOT Save you. It is not the Lord Jesus Christ's precious blood and Saint Louis water that Saves you. It is simply the precious blood of the Lamb, the Lord Jesus Christ's blood, His self-sacrifice on the Cross of Calvary that Save all those that believe on Him.

### **1 Timothy 2:5-6**

5 For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

6 Who gave himself a ransom for **all**, to be testified in due time.

**The **all** is a group --those God has Chosen before the foundation of the world--made up of people from every nation, tongue, and tribe Chosen by God.**

**Mercy is a plea to God to change one's condition; the **all** or those chosen by God before the foundation of the world who have been shown mercy by God to them, and they, too, are called to be merciful reflecting God's mercy toward them:**

Matthew 5:7; Matthew 9:10-13; Matthew 9:27; Matthew 12:1-8; Matthew 15:22; Matthew 17:15; Matthew 20:30-31; Matthew 23:23; Luke 18:9-14; Ephesians 2:1-9

**Who are they this "all" whom God has chosen, and have received His mercy? God's Elect, His Chosen, His Called, His People who were once not a people (the Gentiles):**

Romans 8:33; Romans 9:11; Colossians 3:11-13; 1 Thessalonians 1:4; Titus 1:1-4; 1 Peter 1:1-2; 1 Peter 2:1-25; Ephesians 2:1-22
